



Satisfactory Academic Progress

10,000 Degrees requires all students to meet certain minimum academic requirements in order to qualify for scholarship renewal for the coming academic year. According to your transcript, you either did not maintain at least a 2.0 GPA and/or complete at least 12.0 units in the semester in which you were funded.

In order to be considered for renewal of your scholarship for the next semester, you must:

- 1) Submit a Satisfactory Academic Progress appeal to 10,000 Degrees by **Sept 17th****
- 2) Meet with one of the College Success staff to create a Student Success plan.**

All appeals are reviewed by our Scholarship Committee, which has ultimate authority to renew or deny scholarship applications. Failure to complete any of these steps may result in your renewal application being denied.
